



Next steps...

We are now in the process of developing a site plan that includes such details as hours of operation, noise and dust controls, tree screens, traffic, depth of extraction, phasing of the quarry, rehabilitation requirements and monitoring requirements. An immediate priority is hydrogeological studies to determine the best ways to avoid impacting water quality and supply. Once completed, the site plan will be submitted to the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources.

As our plans take shape, we will hold information sessions in the community to keep you up-to-date and discuss any issues you may have.
